Optional Practical Training (OPT)



Optional Practical Training (OPT) is your opportunity to gain real-world experience that brings your UC education to life.

All F-1 students are eligible for up to one year of OPT for each higher degree earned—empowering you to apply your skills, grow professionally, and make an impact. Whether you're pursuing your first job, a co-op, or a career-launching internship, you don't have to do it alone.

UC's Handshake platform connects you to employers across the country, many of whom welcome international students on OPT and don't require a U.S. work visa.

Curricular Practical Training (CPT)



At University of Cincinnati, learning goes beyond the classroom. For our F-1 Bearcats, Curricular Practical Training (CPT) is a chance to take what you're learning and put it into motion—gaining hands-on experience that's deeply connected to your academic and career journey.

CPT allows temporary off-campus training that's not just optional—it's an essential part of your degree. Whether it's a co-op, internship, practicum, research project, or capstone, CPT experiences are tied directly to your field of study and help you grow as a scholar, a professional, and a global leader.

To qualify, your CPT experience must carry academic credit, be part of UC's course offerings, and be guided by a faculty member or academic advisor. These experiences include:

- Graduate thesis or dissertation research using exclusive resources or facilities

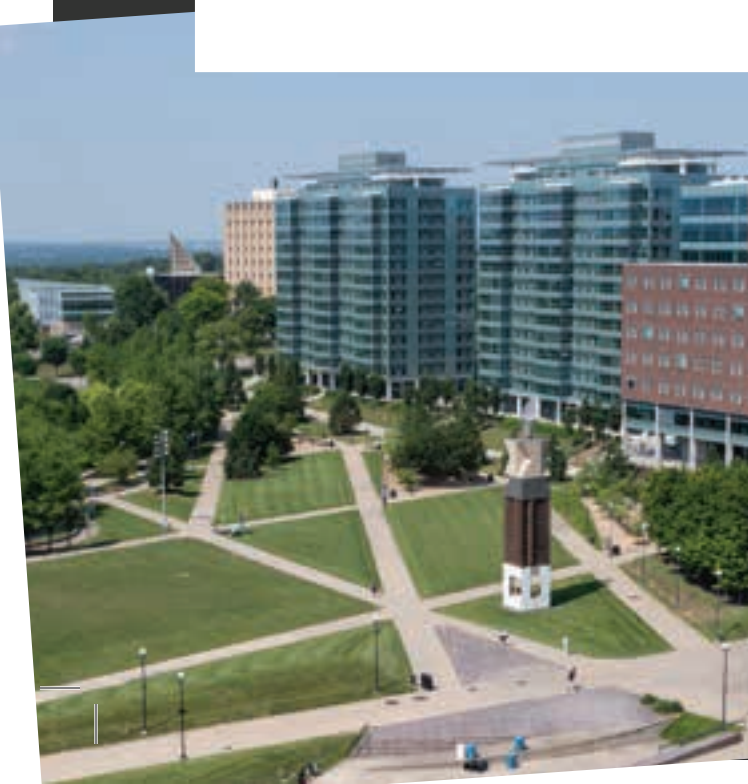

Traditional

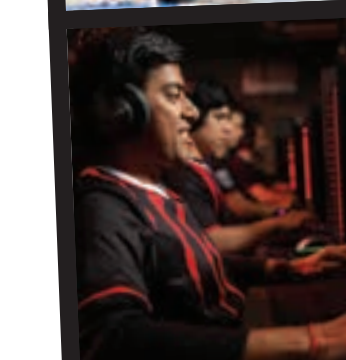
Traditional residence halls are co-ed—either double or quad rooms, with a lounge for each floor. These halls feature a kitchenette and a big screen TV in the lobby.

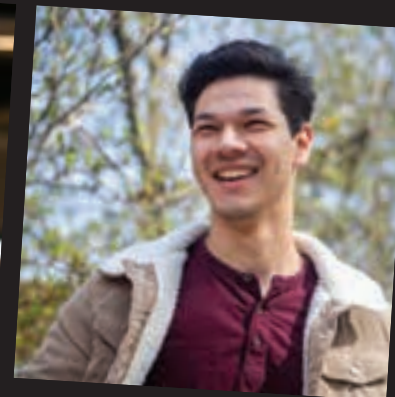
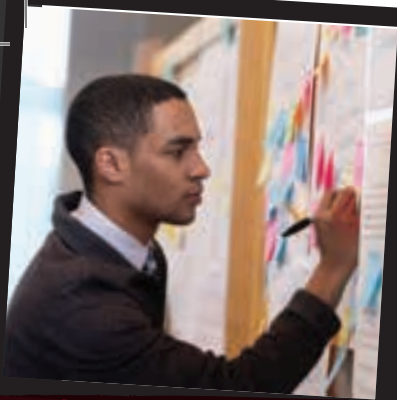
Suite

A Smart Investment

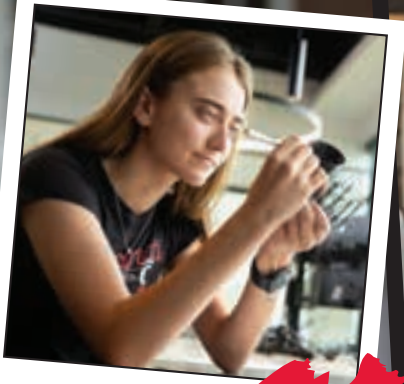
