AMERICAN ENGLISH

Students are able to apply for the fall semester and still earn their bachelor's degree in as little as 4 years. All classes taken over the summer will be counted towards a University of Cincinnati bachelor's degree.

- → No Transcripts Required
- → Lowered English proficiency requirements

Entry Requirements

Only 1 of the following is needed:

- → Completion of ELS 107 (or above) at any ELS Center
- → TOEFL: Minimum writing sub-score of 14 + minimum speaking sub-score of 14
- → IELTS: Minimum writing score of 4.5 + minimum speaking score of 4.5
- → Duolingo: 70

Classes Offered

- → ESL 1068 Foundations of Academic Reading and Writing (3 credit hours)
- → ESL 1069 Success in Undergraduate Academic Writing (3 credit hours)
- → ESL 1071 Basic Oral Communication (3 credit hours)
- → ESL 1077 Strategies for Academic Success (1 credit hour)

Cost of Attendance

\$5,010 to take 10 credit hours \$6,010 to take 12-18 credit hours



Transition into the Fall Semester

Students who meet the Pathway Program minimum will be eligible to enroll in an additional 6-9 credit hours of major-based classes.

All students will be eligible to apply for the International Pathway Program for Fall 2020. English Proficiency will be evaluated on the academic performance achieved during the Bridge Program.
